

Prof. Dr. Cengiz Güleç

Biography

He was born in 1948 in Sivas Şarkışla. Graduated from primary school here. He completed his secondary education at Kabataş High School in Istanbul. After finishing the 1964-65 period at Hacettepe University Faculty of Medicine, he was an expert on Neuro Psychiatry at the Department of Psychiatry of the same faculty in 1976. He went to Paris as a French Government scholarship between 1976-1978. He worked for a period of 15 months as officer at Professor. Dr. P. Pichot's service, in the field of Adolescent (Teenage) psychiatry Paris School of Medicine, Sainte-Anne Psychiatric Hospital, After returning home in 1982, became an associate professor in the Department of Psychiatry, Faculty of Medicine, Hacettepe University. He was appointed professor in 1988. He headed the same department between 1996-1998. He was elected in 1988 and continued the membership elected of faculty board of the Hacettepe University Faculty of Medicine until 11 January 1999.

Dr. Güleç received a certificate of a BA in philosophy from the same university. He has published a book with the counseled of Prof. Dr. Bozkurt Güvenç "Turkish Cultural Identity Crisis" he has received degree for his work in Anthropology Master of Science (MSc) in 1989.
